A. CALL TO ORDER

The special meeting of the Lake and Peninsula Borough Assembly was called to order by Mayor Glen R. Alsworth, Sr. on Saturday October 31, 2015 at 8:31 a.m. in via teleconference from the Borough offices in King Salmon, Alaska.

B. ROLL CALL

A quorum was established with Mayor Glen R. Alsworth, Sr. and Assembly members Randy Alvarez, Alvin Pedersen, Myra Olsen and Michelle Ravenmoon present on the teleconference call. Scott Anderson and Christina Salmon were absent, excused.

Motion was made by Assembly member Pedersen Based up Borough Code Section 4.15.030 (B), a voter has 14 days to appeal a decision of the Canvassing Committee. As such, this meeting needs to be recessed until 8:30 am on November 3rd. Motion was seconded by Assembly member Olsen. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

C. APPROVAL OF AGENDA -

A motion was made by Assembly member Olsen and seconded by Assembly member Ravenmoon to approve the agenda for the special meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. Certify Results of the October 6, 2015 General Election

Kate Conley explained that before she did her election report, she needed to address a voter who was challenging the decision by the Canvass Committee. She explained that Bat D. Anders' ballot was disallowed by the Canvass Committee and his ballot was not opened or counted. The Canvass Committee considered the ballot and the evidence presented and determined Mr. Anders is not a resident of Lake and Peninsula Borough. Mr. Anders objected to the decision. Ms. Conley presented the original information presented to the Canvass Committee, as well as the minutes from the Canvass Committee, and the affidavits from Timothy McKeever, Attorney and from Bat D. Anders. Motion was made by Assembly member Olsen to allow the ballot from Mr. Bat D. Anders to be opened and counted. She added that Mr. Anders is away for school, which is a good reason not to be present in the Borough. Motion was seconded by Assembly member Pedersen. Mayor Alsworth called for discussion. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote. Ms. Conley then opened the ballot of Mr. Anders and added his vote to the final tally.

Ms. Conley gave the Assembly the final report of the election. The final numbers are:

Ms. Conley reported that the total number of ballots cast legally was 335 (This number assumes no questioned or challenged ballots were added to the tally. If all questioned votes are eliminated, this number is 284.)

40% of the total ballots cast legally, as required by LPB municipal code to win, is **134**.

This year the Borough mailed ballots to 1202 registered voters. The Borough has received 119 ballots back as non-deliverable. State election law prevents removal of these voters from the voter registration list, but they can be listed as inactive voters for turnout purposes. Removing the non-deliverable ballots leaves the Borough with 1083 active voters in this election.


