

**LAKE AND PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE NO. 13-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAKE AND PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY EXEMPTING THE BLACK
LAKE WILDLIFE HABITAT STUDY PROJECT FROM COMPETITIVE BID AND DESIGNATING A
SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Lake and Peninsula Borough that:

Section 1. Classification.

This is a Non-Code Ordinance.

Section 2. General Provisions.

The Lake and Peninsula Borough abides by purchasing requirements as set forth in Borough Code 6.24.

Section 3. Justification.

A. Background. A two year project to monitor the sockeye smolt and evaluate the work has been approved for funding by the Coastal Impact Assessment Program (CIAP) for \$107,800. Chignik Regional Aquaculture Association (CRAA) will be funding \$57,184 for the project. The total project cost is \$164,984.00. CRAA has done previous work on the project, has project orientation and experience, and the US Fish and Wildlife Service (which operates the CIAP program) has agreed a sole source is the most efficient method to proceed with the project.

B. Law. Lake and Peninsula Borough code 6.24.090 reads:
“Unless otherwise prohibited or exempted by borough ordinance, all contracts and purchases for an amount estimated to exceed fifty thousand dollars shall be by competitive sealed bid.” The Assembly must approve any sole source bid award by ordinance

C. Justification. Because a portion of the funding has been provided by CRAA, because CRAA comes to the project with considerable existing experience and background, and because a sole source contract has been pre-approved by the US Fish & Wildlife Service, there is little, if any, benefit to the time and expense of a competitive process. The Assembly concludes that a sole source contracts is appropriate in the special circumstances of this case.

Section 4. Award of Contract

The Borough awards Chignik Regional Aquaculture Association a sole source contract to complete a two year sockeye smolt evaluation at Black Lake for \$164,984.00

Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment by the Borough Assembly.


