

LAKE AND PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 15-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH MANAGER TO DISTRIBUTE FY-2015 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX FUNDS TO UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES WITHIN THE LAKE AND PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, Lake and Peninsula Borough will receive \$26,181.53 from the State from the three fisheries management areas within the Borough, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly would like to distribute these funds as fairly as possible to those communities with the least resources, and

WHEREAS the communities which are incorporated receive larger State revenue sharing funds and have a greater capacity to impose, levy and collect taxes and fees, and

WHEREAS, a method to distribute community revenue sharing already exists per Ordinance 93-08 further provides that twenty-five percent (25%) of the funds appropriated for the purpose of Borough Revenue Sharing shall be distributed equally among the sixteen communities, and seventy five percent (75%) shall be distributed on the basis of population as determined by the latest U.S. census or by such other information as the Borough Assembly may determine accurately reflects the actual year-around population of each community, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Economic Development has recently determined population estimates, which are believed by the Borough Assembly to reflect the most recent and accurate community estimates available.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Manager is hereby authorized to distribute appropriated FY-2015 shared fisheries business tax funds in accordance with the conditions and requirements set forth in Section 6.02.020 of the Borough Municipal Code and in the amounts set forth in the attached schedule identified as "Exhibit A" which is incorporated herein by reference, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds distributed to Borough communities may be used by those communities for any public purpose as defined in Section 6.02.090 of the Municipal Code which reads as follows:

" Public Purpose" means a purpose that serves the convenience, safety, or welfare of the entire community and not the welfare of a specific individual or class of persons; the essential requisite being that the service or use so provided shall affect the inhabitants as a community, and not merely as individuals.


