Chapter 7.01 PROVISION OF ROAD SERVICES WITHIN THE BOROUGH

7.01.010 Area of Service

State Shared Revenues for road maintenance within the Lake and Peninsula Borough shall be provided on a non-areawide basis to all areas outside the boundaries of any incorporated city within the Lake and Peninsula Borough except for roads outside of city boundaries maintained by cities as of the date of approval of this ordinance.

7.01.020 Responsibility of Borough Assembly

- A. The assembly shall adopt an annual budget for road maintenance and repair. The budget shall identify the amount of money to be conveyed for road services within each eligible unincorporated community within the Borough. An eligible unincorporated community includes Native village governments or community associations representing unincorporated communities within the Borough.
- B. The Borough shall apply for state revenue sharing funds for road services annually.
- C. When State revenue sharing funds for road services have been received by the Borough, the Borough Clerk shall transfer the budgeted amount for road services to the village council of each eligible unincorporated community within the Borough.
- D. The assembly shall retain the power to approve or disapprove any contract entered into by any eligible unincorporated community which requires payment from funds budgeted for road services by the Borough.
- E. The Borough shall provide each eligible unincorporated community forms for submitting expense reports required by this Chapter.

7.01.030 Responsibility of Eligible Unincorporated Communities

- A. Each eligible unincorporated community shall prepare and submit to the assembly for approval an annual budget for road maintenance and repair no later than April 15th of each year.
- B. Each eligible unincorporated community shall administer all funds received from the Borough for road services, including but not limited to, soliciting bids, awarding contracts, making payments in accordance with all contracts awarded, and directing the contractor in the performance of the contract; however, all contracts which require payment from funds budgeted by the assembly for road

services shall be subject to the approval of the assembly.

- C. Each eligible unincorporated community shall report to the Borough on January 15 and June 30 all money spent from funds transferred to the village council by the Borough for road services during the past six months. Said reports shall be submitted on forms provided by the Borough. Each village shall provide such further documentation regarding road service expenses as the Borough manager may require.
