**Chapter 8.01 PROVISION OF HEALTH SERVICES WITHIN THE BOROUGH**

**8.01.010 Area of Service.**

State Shared Revenues for the maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies for health facilities within the Lake and Peninsula Borough shall be provided on a non-area-wide basis to all areas outside the boundaries of any incorporated City within the Lake and Peninsula Borough.

**8.01.020 Responsibility of Borough.**

- A. The assembly shall adopt an annual budget for health facilities maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies. The budget shall identify the amount of money to be spent for health facilities maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies within each unincorporated community within the Borough. An eligible unincorporated community includes Native village governments or community associations with health care facilities.
- B. The Borough shall apply for state revenue sharing funds for health facilities annually.
- C. When State revenue sharing funds for health facilities have been received by the Borough, the Borough Clerk shall transfer the budgeted amount for health facilities maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies to each eligible unincorporated community within the Borough.
- D. The assembly shall retain the power to approve or disapprove any contract entered into by any eligible unincorporated community which requires payment from funds budgeted for health facilities by the Borough.
- E. The Borough shall provide each eligible unincorporated community forms for submitting the expense reports required by this chapter.

**8.01.030 Responsibility of Eligible Unincorporated Communities.**

- A. Each eligible unincorporated community shall prepare and submit to the assembly for approval an annual budget for health clinic maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies no later than April 15 of each year.
- B. Each eligible unincorporated community shall administer all funds received from the Borough for health facilities, however, all contracts which require

payment from funds budgeted by the assembly for health facilities shall be subject to the approval of the assembly.

- C. Each eligible unincorporated community shall report to the Borough on January 15 and June 30 all money spent from funds transferred to the eligible unincorporated community by the Borough for the maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies of health facilities during the past six months and shall provide such other documentation concerning health facilities maintenance, repair, equipment and supplies expenses as the Borough manager may require. Said reports shall be submitted on forms provided by the Borough.
