Re: November Managers Report

In the last month I have been in touch with staff, consultants, residents, and assembly on a near daily basis. The work has been mostly focused on the culmination of information for the final meeting of 2022. A continuation of the works in progress we have on many fronts including but not limited to infrastructure related projects and school related projects.

I have been working closely with Gavin Dixon on a multitude of infrastructure related projects Borough wide. The main borough CIP projects as well as a long list of projects collected in our communities over the last year will be shared at the upcoming meeting. This has occurred since we were initially informed of the significant funding resource that would be put into motion via the Federal Infrastructure Bill last November. I feel that we have been successful so far and look forward to further success in the years to come.

The school superintendent, finance, and borough finance continued conversations regarding the needs of the school district refining priorities and identifying costs associated with those needs. It is a starting point for a Borough/District effort to make a sustainable maintenance plan for our aging infrastructure. In other school related news, I was also approached by Pedro Bay with a proposal regarding the acquisition of the housing units in Pedro Bay.

I have also asked Deerstone to help put together a summary of the broadband funding opportunities and projects already funded. There have been several inquiries and communications regarding broadband over the last year so I am hoping it will be helpful in conveying the subject that has been relatively confusing to track.
